## **ACTION POINTS**

These are the action points agreed to carry on after the GBIF mentoring hold in Madrid in January 21-23 with the Nodes of France, Portugal and Spain. All information related to this event is here: http://www.gbif.es/formaciondetalles.php?IDForm=124#ad-image-0

Block 2 (data quality)

- 1. <u>**GBIF Spain**</u> will maintain the data quality hub until the Secretariat creates a functional service.
- 2. Olaf will be contacted **by Anne-Sophie** about the ORC (how is it possible to browse items on the ORC, how to find the key documents for each theme, etc).
- Atlas of living Australia Portal : we discussed the possibilities to implement that code at a national level. We are interested in knowing the Secretariat plans to take part in the coordinating. <u>Marie-Elise and Santiago</u> will write to Tim Robertson about it.
- 4. We need an IT meeting before the European nodes meeting in Brussels. <u>Anne-Sophie</u> will contact André and Olaf.
- 5. How do we use Google Refine in the context of Darwin Core? <u>Rui</u> is going to prepare an example.
- 6. Question to Burke: when an IPT resource is updated, can the relevant node be informed? **Paco** will ask Burke.

Block 3 and 4 (Apparent Quality Index)

- To package the GBIF Spain intranet as a GitHub project so it can be explored and deployed by the other GBIF nodes ----> Finally, we will share it in private with GBIF Portugal and GBIF France so they can have an idea of GBIF Spain's intranet structure (<u>Santiago</u>)
- 8. To make available the Darwin Test validations as an online resource. (Santiago)
- 9. Possibilities of exploring the development of a cross-platform tool to perform validations of DwC-A. (<u>GBIF Portugal</u>)
- 10. Christian Gendreau from Canadensys is working on the Darwin Core Archive Validator; he asked other developers from other nodes to help him. (Marie-Elise and Santiago)

Blocks 5, 6 and 7 (e-Learning)

- 11. <u>GBIF France and GBIF Portugal</u> are really interested in using the platform, re-use the contents and customize the courses (subtitles, new videos, etc).
- 12. Making a prototype using the Amara platform. (Cristina and Paco)
- 13. GBIF Spain will move the e-learning platform to a Linux environment and will notify the partners in this endeavor. <u>GBIF France</u> will translate and test the e-learning platform.

Block 8 (Internationalization and localization)

14. Question: is there a specific place where to address this issue in the GBIF documents? There needs to be a paragraph about it in the documents about publishing data and the documentation about data quality in the GBIF network has to be updated. (<u>Rui</u>)

Block 9 (Persistent Identifiers)

15. We request a session on persistent identifiers plans with GBIF representatives at the European Nodes Meeting. We want to know where we are going. (Anne-Sophie)
