Goals:

- Project focused to strengthen and build capacities in the nodes of Ecuador and Chile that will allow both nodes to develop a national strategy of data mobilization and enhance cooperation between GBIF members in the region.
- Visit to SiB Colombia to instruct the staff from Chilean and Ecuadorian Nodes in processing and publishing data: using metadata standard, cleaning data, normalize data using Darwin Core standard, the use of IPT.
